Seminar Content:

We will assess the canine behavior characteristics we see on temperament evaluations and determine how to best match dogs to new homes or to train them for successful human partnerships and endeavors for life.

This seminar will also take a constructive approach to using reinforcement and timeouts to teach self-control skills in every part of the dog's life with us. To learn, the dog must be able to think and to think requires self control.

Morning Session:

- evaluation tools and skills
- setting up plans for successful
 - placement
 - socialization
 - training objectives
- identifying the right home or role so our dogs won't end up back in the system.

Afternoon Session :

The focus will be on:

- The basics of self control
- Using what the dogs want to show him how to “manipulate” us to get it
 - To leave the house/kennel, the door will not open unless the dog backs up.
 - To get attention and treats in the house/kennel, the dog has to put his butt on the ground.
 - To go for a walk, the dog has to walk nicely or wear a gentle leader/sensation-harness and not pull.

Follow up and lots of time for discussion.

Directions:

Your Dog's Place is located on Route 191, 3 Miles north of Honesdale, Pa. Heading North out of town you will pass the Wayne County Fairgrounds, the Jadwin Dam, and Dyberry Sporting Clays on your left. Next you will see 3 green metal buildings on the left.
